Christ has no body now on earth but yours, No hands but yours, No feet but yours. Yours are the eyes through which he looks with compassion on the world.


Yours are the feet with which he is to go about doing good; Yours are the hands with which he is to bless men now.

Many Koinonians are wondering.... how long do I have serve as Wheat before serving in the community room for a retreat?

That is an excellent question! It is not as complicated as it might seem.

The requirement for serving in the Community Room for a Koinonia Retreat is —

- ₱ Must have worked Wheat at least once
- Send in a Team Application putting down the desired position you would like to serve in.
- → Be willing to present a mediation.

The Community Room positions available to serve in are: Table Leaders, Assistant Spiritual Director, Lay Director, Co- Lay Director, musicians and Gopher.

Each of the positions in the Community Room require that the person present a meditation. If you look at your Koinonia booklets from being a candidate you will see what the meditation topics are.

Do not be nervous or afraid to serve in these positions!! Why? Because each position comes with a detailed manual explaining the duties and guidelines of the position. There is also a guideline booklet for each of the meditations.

During the planning meeting there is table leader training and your meditation is presented in front of the Community Room team.

We STRONGLY ENCOURAGE you to experience serving in the community room.

Please submit your Team Application as soon as possible for K #44 in Phillips coming in April. *Positions are assigned on a First Come – First Serve basis.* The sooner your application is received the better chance you have to get the position you want! If interested in presenting a specific meditation, list the meditation name on your application.
